Come along to the PTA Te Whiti Riser Twilight Walk!

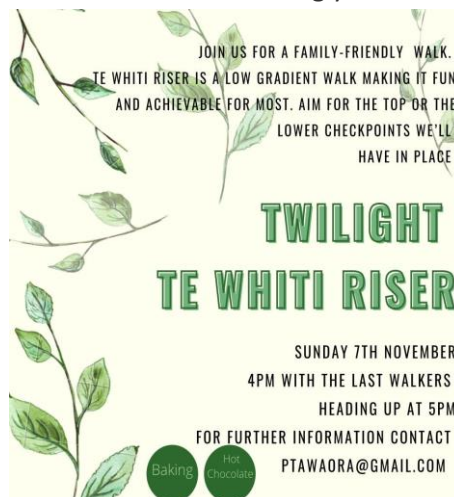
It is a great chance to get out into nature on this low gradient pram accessible walk with friends and family.

- And the CEO, Olivia (right) came second place for the YES National CEO of the Year award!



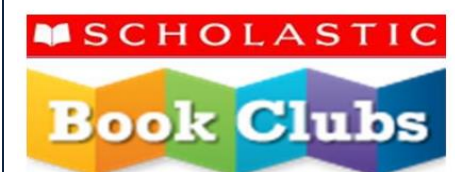
### Naenae Village Market
